

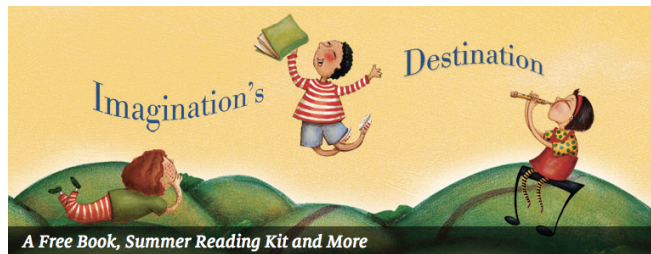
Summer Reading Opportunities

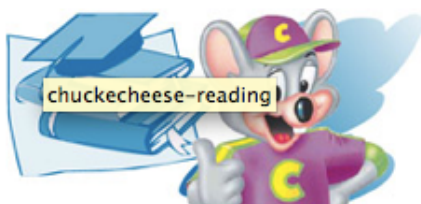
